Contact4Me

Alzheimer Scotland was recently contacted by Sue Salik, Director of Contact4Me, a Personal Emergency Database Service which provides members with a service that notifies their loved ones and next of kin after an emergency occurrence. In everyday life the unexpected can happen. Yet we rarely carry the necessary information to identify our next of kin or other contacts we would wish to be notified in an emergency situation.

Contact4Me allows members to store up to 10 phone numbers and medical alerts on their very own Personal Emergency Database (PED.) A family member can administer a membership on behalf of another member of their family. If an incident should happen, anyone can call the Contact4Me number to explain the situation and describe the incident. A call from the call centre will then be made to the first name on the database to inform them that a member is in difficulty and the person at the scene is then connected to the personal contact. The call centre will stay on the line until a suitable contact is established.
